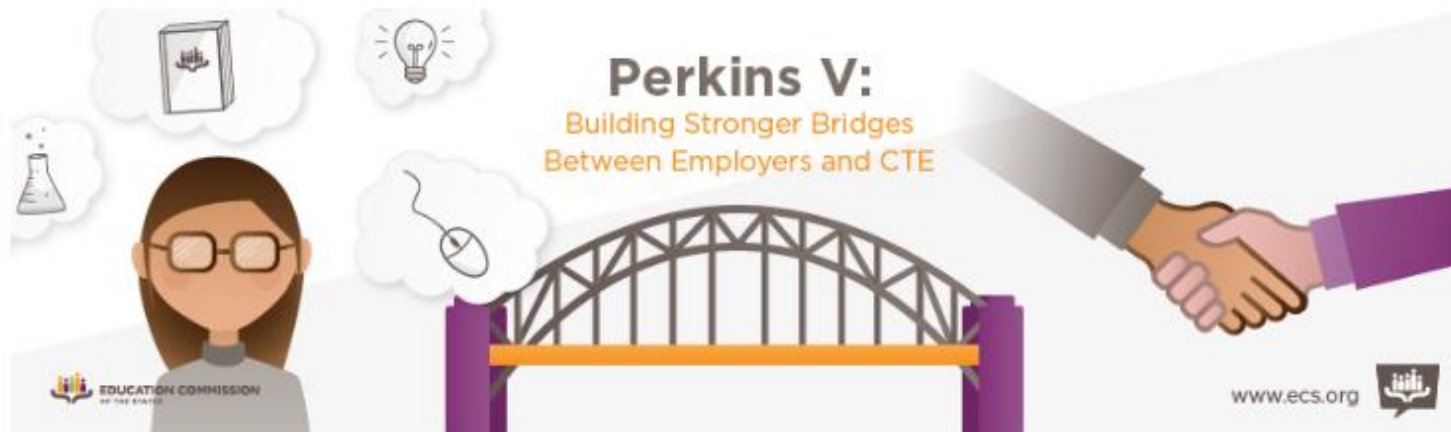
Total Enrollment: 56,394
